OF A TWO PART INTERVIEW WITH FORENSIC LINGUIST AND AUTHOR, JOE KOENIG

GETTING THE TRUTH "I am DB Cooper"



PAT BRUDER: Anyone who has followed the DB Cooper high jacking knows there are a number of individuals who claim to know the real DB Cooper. In your book, **GETTING THE TRUTH: I am D.B. Cooper**, your research and forensic analysis make a compelling case that Walt Reza is the real DB Cooper. The friendship and communications between two men, Carl Laurin and Walt Reza, in combination with the FBI evidence contribute to your conclusion that Walt Reza is DB Cooper.

JOE KOENIG: I am convinced Walt Reza is DB Cooper. My case is the only evidence-based DB Cooper account. All the others are theory-based. Primarily, we have Walt's confession to Carl Laurin. In the beginning of my investigation, I went to Carl Laurin's home in Florida for several days to interview him and evaluate all the correspondence, recordings, and artifacts.

PB: In your first book, **GETTING THE TRUTH: Discover the Real Message. Know Truth. Know Deception**, you explain Forensic Linguistics and how to conduct

interviews, so not to contaminate the interview process with leading and suggestive questions. Joe, what techniques did you employ to neutralize any contamination that Carl Laurin may have inadvertently introduced into his interviews with Walt Reza?

JK: Great question. Carl and Walt began talking about Walt being DB Cooper as early as 1998 and they did not stop communicating and collecting data until 2014, when Walt passed away. I evaluated and studied Carl's conversation patterns as much as I studied Walt's to precisely understand the patterns and interactions of both. I was convinced Walt was telling the truth despite Carl's contamination. I had over three hours of tape recordings, over a hundred pages of transcripts. I had a lot of material to work with.

PB: How did you employ Forensic Linguistics to distinguish truthfulness from deception while you were interviewing Carl Laurin?

JK: I spent three days conducting forensic interviews with Carl and his wife Loretta to help determine their truthfulness, consistency and accuracy. Both not only believed Walt was DB Cooper, but they also demonstrated that in all their responses they were consistent in their physical and emotional reactions. Their behaviors were always consistent with truthfulness, showing no signs of deception.

Not only was I examining how

Carl responded, I also, without her knowledge, examined his wife's reactions to Carl's responses. In that way, I could get confirmation as to my conclusions about Carl being genuine and telling the truth, in part because of the reactions of his wife. Wives can give you away in a hurry.

PB: We are good at that. It goes both ways.

JK: Additionally, I thoroughly researched the evidence provided by the FBI as well as Carl's artifacts and data. Carl carefully preserved all the DB Cooper and Walt Reza artifacts and conversations. He had dedicated many years to his belief that his friend, Walter Reza was indeed DB Cooper.

In his collection of DB Cooper and Walt Reza artifacts, Carl had the long underwear Walt wore the night of the hijacking, consistent with the statements in the recordings between Walt and Carl, and transcribed word for word in my book. Carl had articles documenting the history of the case taped to the walls. He had all the notes, diaries, and miscellaneous items Walt had sent to him all of which lent credibility to Walt's statements to Carl in those recordings.

Further, Walt's sister and her daughter, Lisa Story, revealed to me their conversations with Walt about him being DB Cooper. Lisa asked Walt why he did it and Walt replied, "I'd rather be

dead than poor," explaining his depression and wanting to leave something to his family. He was always a risk-taker and an expert paratrooper. One of the artifacts Carl and Lisa have included Walt's identification pieces with a legitimate appearing KGB identification and passports, with Walt's picture under different names. All of which supports the belief that Walt worked for some governmental intelligence, perhaps using him in spy-type work. Walt may have been a hitman as reflected in my book.

In addition to contemporaneous admissions to Carl and Lisa Story (and Lisa's mother, Walt's sister), Lisa told me they talked Walt out of signing a Carl Laurin generated confession. Carl had put together a confession statement asking Walt to sign for future proof of Walt identity as DB Cooper. Lisa talked Walt out of signing that confession. Because Carl had written it based on his interviews with Walt, I never used that confession as part of my analysis. However, Walt agreed with its contents according to Lisa Story and did not sign it only because of Lisa's wishes.

We confirmed many of the details Walt revealed in Carl's recordings (later transcribed for my analysis). Walt said he

bought a home in Portland with the hijacking cash - and we confirmed that by contacting the former owner who described Walt and his wife, and confirmed Walt paid for the house in cash.

PB: What about the FBI evidence? Does it support or counter your conclusion that Walt Reza is DB Cooper?

JK: In addition to the forensic analysis of the recordings, I evaluated all the FBI interviews with the crewmembers and interviews with all the individuals named by Walt Reza to verify the timeline and sequence of events. They align perfectly with Walt's account of the high jacking, both before and after.

PB: Walt described in detail his interactions with the flight attendant during the hijacking. Would you share with our readers that exchange?

JK: In Walt Reza's account he gave the flight attendant Florence Schaffner a note. It read, "Miss - I have a bomb here and I would like you to sit by me." Schaffner described the note. She said the "Miss" was printed and the rest was written in legible handwriting. Walt practiced calligraphy and his writing was particularly good. We have handwritten letters sent to Lisa as evidence. Schaffner read the note twice and asked Cooper if he was kidding, to which he responded, "No, miss, this is for real." Schaffner handed the note to the other flight attendant Tina Mucklow, who then called the cockpit. Cooper told Schaffner to write down his demands: "I want \$200,000 by 5:00 PM in cash. Put it in a knapsack. I want two back parachutes and two front parachutes. When we land, I want a fuel truck ready to refuel. No funny stuff, or I will do the job."

PB: There are conflicting statements about DB Coopers eye color. Whether they were brown or blue. Can you provide clarification on that?

JK: Flight attendant Tina Mucklow, by far, spent the most time with Cooper. Mucklow said Cooper kept his sunglasses on the entire time, never taking them off. She never gave his eye color. The hijacker's eye color was also described as blue in other witness statements. Cooper had ordered the lights in the plane off so if he did take his sunglasses off, eye color would have been difficult to discern.

PB: Let's talk about after Walt jumped from the aircraft. He made his way to a cafe and called his friend for help. Take us through the events from the time he landed after parachuting from the aircraft..

JK: An incredible piece of evidence centers on the Teanaway Cafe. Walt described the Teanaway Cafe in his recordings as the cafe he walked to after the hijacking. It has long since been torn down - however, we confirmed its existence in the 70's, finding it was replaced by a new fire department building. We confirmed the setting as Walt described it in his statement.

Jeff "Cowboy" Osiadacz, a former police officer and well-respected member of the Cle Elum community, gave us several interviews. Jeff stated he saw Walt walking on the road and later interacted with Walt inside the Teanaway Cafe. Jeff's description of Walt, aka DB Cooper, coupled with the timing of the interaction not only matched Walt and Carl's conversation recordings but also matched the time frame of the hijacking. I applied forensic linguistics to Jeff's

transcripts of his memories which exactly mirrored Walt's earlier statements to Carl. I found his statements to be consistent and truthful. Jeff provided a hand-written statement as well. Jeff's memories matched Carl's recordings of Walt's memories the night of the hijacking and his walk to the Teanaway Cafe (in Cle Elum) following his parachute landing.

We also confirmed that Walt called his friend Don Brennan from the Teanaway Cafe. Walt asked Jeff "Cowboy" Osiadacz, to tell Don Brennan how to get to the Teanaway Cafe to pick Walt up. Cowboy gave directions to the man on the phone. When Brennan picked up Walt, Walt gave Brennan "a few bundles of money" and stated, "Now, we're in this together."

After the sky jacking, Brennan was interviewed by the FBI as a possible suspect, so we know Brennan was paranoid. Also interesting, Don Brennan had moved to a trailer south of Tacoma. He was assigned work as far south as Portland, so he drove through the Tena Bar area where in 1980, \$5800 of the highjacked money was found by a young boy. We believe Don tossed or hid the money in or near that location because it was evidence. Alternatively, Don may have dumped the money to obscure the actual drop zone of Cle Elum. It is important to note that the money was found wrapped in rubber bands, not

bank tape. The money was in a condition which the FBI felt was not consistent with being there since 1971.

PB: Regarding the tie and tie clip left behind on the highjacked plane by DB Cooper. Can you provide any details that link Walt to that tie and tie clip?

JK: Walter Reza stated he got that tie at a secondhand store just before the hijacking so DNA could be anybody's. However, we need to keep in mind that the hijacking occurred long before DNA technology was available, so it is possible that the FBI did not store the cigarettes or the tie properly to preserve DNA evidence. Another important piece of the DB Cooper identity is that Walt Reza smoked

Parliament cigarettes which matched the cigarettes smoked by DB Cooper on the plane that the FBI seized as evidence and later lost (suspiciously). I can't fathom how that could have occurred. DNA is a complex item of evidence, and in the Cooper case, they supposedly had some DNA, or they might've had some DNA on the tie.

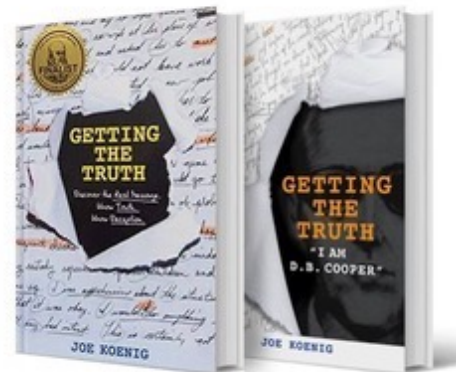
PB: To this day there is a point of contention on the purported flight path of the highjacked Northwest flight #305. Can you offer more clarification?

JK: My investigation maintains that the actual flight path taken is Victor 2; the FBI said the flight path was Victor 23. I interviewed a pilot who flew the same type of aircraft out of the Sea-Tac International Airport, and he stated emphatically that given the requirements of a 10,000 foot altitude the preferred route was Victor 2 because of the mountain ranges in Victor 23 was too high (Mt. Baker and Mt. St. Helens). Remember the visibility on that night was not good. Victor 2 goes over some relative flatlands near Cle Elum. Also, it is important to note that commercial pilots would normally fly over the ocean if a bomb were onboard. Walt Recca said he wanted to go to Mexico - the pilot said they did not have the fuel and had to route toward Reno, NV.

Radar in 1971 was not what it is today.

The copilot of the highjacked plane, Bill Rataczak, has given varied descriptions of the flight path over the years. Former FBI Agent Himmelsbach reported that Rataczak told him the flight was east of Ariel. Experienced pilot Ken Wierenga told us his greatest concern would be icing while flying at 10,000 feet and therefore would have avoided the mountains by flying east toward Yakima (directly over Cle Elum). Rataczak reported he was concerned about icing. The personal notes of Northwest Orient employee George Harrison, who took notes from the SeaTac tower that night, wrote that the flight path and the radar pings from that night confirmed the flight path in my book. The FBI later admitted they probably reached the wrong conclusion about the flight path and the drop zone could have been off by as much as 80°.

PB: The research, the evidence, and most importantly your forensic analysis demonstrating truthfulness and no deception on the part of Walt Recca and Carl Laurin clearly differentiates Walter Recca from the others as being the real DB Cooper. The book is a must read. Joe, thank you for sharing this incredible journey with our readers.

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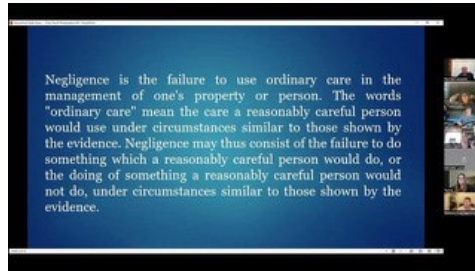

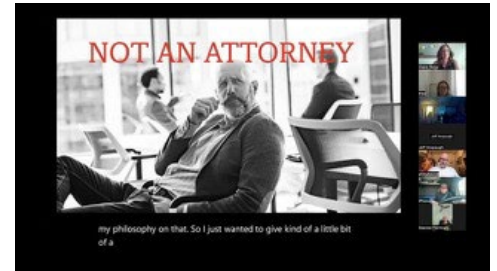

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The Certified Private Investigator Exam is more comprehensive than ever and is now available ONLINE! Approved applicants may take the CPI exam online via the PIAI website. To qualify, complete the CPI application process. Upon approval you will be assigned an exam code which enables you to take the CPI exam online.

The Certified Private Investigator program is a nationwide certification that provides objective proof and verification of outstanding knowledge, experience and proficiency in the private investigation field. Administered by the PIAI, the CPI certification grants the use of the professional designation Certified Private Investigator, it's post nominals CPI (i.e. John Davis CPI), and the CPI logo.

Certified Private Investigator Application Requirements:

- **EXPERIENCE.** Applicants must have a minimum of 500 verifiable investigative hours. Military & law enforcement: 50% reduction to 250 hours verifiable hours of professional work experience. Private Investigation Education: 25% reduction to 375 verifiable hours of professional work experience..
- **INSURANCE.** Applicants must provide proof of and maintain general liability insurance including errors & omissions with a minimum \$500,000 coverage.
- **LICENSING.** Applicants must possess and maintain a private investigator license issued by their city and/or state of practice where licensing is required. CPI certification does not substitute license requirements by local authorities.
- **AGE.** Applicants must be at least 21 years old.

Application: Submit a completed application with any applicable background check fees and accompanied by three professional, industry-related references who have known the applicant for at least three years.

Interview: Upon application approval and successful background check, applicant must complete an oral interview by the certification board.

Exam: Applicant must pass a certification exam comprised of approximately 175 questions with at least an 80% score. The timed exam must be completed within 6 hours.

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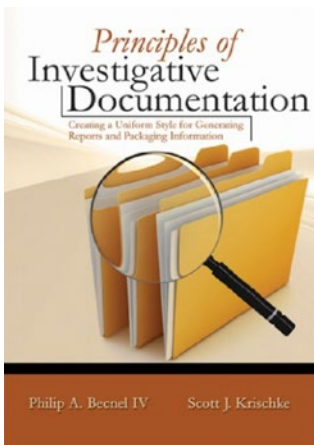


The Investigator's Little Black Book 3
